

A joint meeting between the Yorkshire and Humber Network and Leeds Beckett University was held to launch the PHE funded Whole Systems Approach to Obesity project.

The meeting was attended by over 220 people from across the UK. The event chaired by Professor Pinki Sahota, Chair of ASO welcomed Professor Steven Allender, Co-Director, World Health Organisation Collaborating Centre at Deakin University, who provided an insightful and inspirational presentation about the work they have been doing using systems science to support the development of childhood obesity prevention programmes.

Jaime Blackshaw, National Programme Lead for obesity at Pubic Health England, shared an overview of where the Whole Systems Approach to Tackling Obesity fits within the work plans of Public Health England.

Professor Paul Gately, Leeds Beckett University followed by outlining the study which aims to work collaboratively to co-produce with local authorities and key stakeholders locally relevant solutions to tackling obesity.

Over the last 30 minutes we welcomed Carol Weir and Professor Rob Copeland, Sheffield Hallam University to the panel to share their experiences undertaking the delivery and evaluation of Sheffield Let's Change 4 Life which is the only whole systems approach to tackling childhood obesity undertaken in the UK to date.
