



UKCO2018 POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

The Poster Sessions will take place in **Kings Hall, Armstrong Building** on both Thursday 6th and Friday 7th during the lunch breaks. (Thursday 13.00 to 14.30 and Friday 13.00 – 14.15). The poster area will be clearly signposted and we recommend that you hang your poster on Thursday morning.

Please follow the tips below to assist with the preparation of your poster

- The poster boards will be **Portrait Size 100cm (wide) x 200cm (high)**. Your poster should not exceed the size of the poster board and we recommend that you prepare your poster A0 size, (84.1 x 118.9cm). Do not prepare a landscape poster.
- Posters must be attached to the poster boards using the materials provided by the venue.
- Posters will be displayed in numerical order and poster numbers will be printed in the conference book.
- Posters should be readable from a distance of a few feet. Use a dark print in a block style on a light background with a matt finish. This will help improve legibility.
- It is recommended that you provide the viewer (using numbers or arrows) a preferred sequence that should be followed while reading your poster.
- Your poster should be self-explanatory so that you are free to offer further information and discuss particular points during the poster session.
- ASO strongly recommends that you read their **position paper on Weight Bias and Stigma** before you prepare your poster. (this can found on the ASO website at <http://www.aso.org.uk/events/ukco/abstract-submission/>).
- Please include contact details on your poster in case someone requires additional information.
- The use of the ASO or UKCO logo is not permitted. Do not write on the poster boards themselves.

Please note that the organisers are not responsible for posters. If you wish to keep your poster, it must be collected no later than 15.00 hrs on the Friday.
